Easter Sunday

April 1, 2018



From Fr. Steffl:

I wish everyone a **joyful celebration of Easter!** Thanks to everyone who worked in various ways to make this Holy Week and Easter a prayerful celebration. Our faith should be the center of all we do; and being reminded of the Lord Jesus' Passion and Death for us on the Cross, and His Resurrection, which offers us the possibility of eternal life with Him, **helps us to find purpose and meaning to our lives.**

Catholics, come home! I **pray each day for those who have fallen away from the practice of their faith** from our parishes and families. (And I am pleased that the Lord has answered my prayers...) Please join me in praying for the return of those who have fallen away from the Church and those who simply do not practice their Faith and receive the Sacraments regularly.

Confessions – I am **glad for all those who took seriously the call to conversion that necessarily includes the Sacrament of Reconciliation during this season of Lent.** I am personally convinced that this Sacrament is absolutely necessary in helping us as individuals to grow in a personal relationship with Jesus, and the Church has proclaimed this for centuries! Unfortunately, it is so easy to put off this Sacrament, or make it much harder than it really is... Now that you have received it, don't put it off again. When I am asked, I always recommend at least going every month (many people have the practice of going around the First Friday of each month so it does not get forgotten...) Is it easy to confess? No, because our sin is always unpleasant to deal with; but it is much worse to avoid the Sacrament of Jesus' Mercy... And if we find we don't have anything at all to bring to this Sacrament, it is because we haven't looked hard enough. I have examinations of conscience available outside the confessionals at both St. Catherine's and St. John's, and it is easy to find other versions on line. Does it seem like we repeat the same things? Often, yes, but it at least shows the Lord that we are continuing to work on our defects and those things that tempt us or lead us away from Jesus. And above all, as a Sacrament, it is an occasion of Sanctifying Grace, which we should always want to have.

A number of parishioners from both parishes attended the **Chrism Mass**, that was Thursday, March 22 at the Cathedral in New Ulm. In our diocese, the location changes each year because of the distances we have geographically. In addition to the 3 oils that are used in the Sacraments being blessed, the Mass is also focused on the priesthood. The priests of every diocese gather with their bishop at this Mass to renew their own priestly vows that were made on their ordination day. It is a reminder to us of how important the priesthood is to our lives as Catholics, and how important it is for us to continue to pray for priestly and religious vocations from our parishes and for our diocese. This, too, is a daily prayer intention of mine, that there could be at least one seminarian from each of our parishes very soon. This last year, a young lady from St. Catherine's entered the novitiate to be a Carmelite Sister in Nebraska, Martha Kodet. Her brother, Fr. John Kodet was the last priest from St. Catherine's, ordained 2 years ago for the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter, and who is assigned by his religious community to a parish in Ohio. **As the Bishop said at the Chrism Mass, "priests just don't fall out of the sky in our laps, but they come from families who have to encourage such vocations"** so if we fell a shortage of vocations, it is because we haven't done all we need to be doing, both in prayer and encouragement.

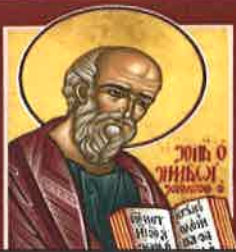

Fr. Steffl's one more note:



Over my time here since I arrived, I have been approached many times about looking into the possibility of "finishing the stained glass windows" in St. Catherine's. People have mentioned being distracted by things and people outside, and that it looks like we didn't have the money to finish a project that we started. So I looked into it, and have a few different ideas to propose, and am looking for feedback as to whether to pursue the project, leave it be for the time, or start thinking of possibilities. One possibility is posted on the bulletin board in the gathering space that would incorporate the Sacraments by the same company that did the original windows that are already installed. They could incorporate other ideas or scenes from Scripture, Mysteries of the Rosary, etc. Another idea is from a different individual who would make the lower windows with a center medallion that would be a title of Mary or Joseph. Windows like this are, of course costly, but also a personal and lifetime investment in the beauty of the parish church, and also a reminder of different aspects of our faith, a sort of "canvas" of catechesis. A "rough" idea of the cost would be about \$2700 per window panel. I invite all comments, positive and negative.
