The Most Holy Trinity

May 27, 2018



From Fr. Steffl:

Next week is **Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Holy Body and Blood of Jesus**. At the end of the 9:30 am Mass at St Catherine's on June 3rd, we will have a Eucharistic Procession like we did last year, into Rademacher Hall, then to the Old Social Hall, and ending up in the church. In a special way, we invite the 2nd graders who made their First Communion this year from both parishes to wear their First Communion clothes and be a special part of this procession.



The feedback regarding the **calendar raffle** that we did for the first time this last year has been very favorable. It was a good project to share between our parishes, and we publish the winners each week for everyone to see. The profits were divided between St Catherine's and St John's on a pro-rated basis, that is based on the percentage of calendars sold by each parish. The money went into the general fund this year, not being designated for a specific need. I think it was a successful fundraiser, and hope to see it continued.

A few weeks ago, I wrote about **Catholic Healthcare Directives**, and gave a web page on the Diocesan web site as a reference. I also have some paper copies available from Rita in the St Catherine's Parish Office. A Healthcare Directive is a legal document governing end of life issues and often times lawyers will recommend them and hospitals and clinics ask about them. They are helpful to have, when it comes to having to make "end of life" decisions, that they are made according to the Church's teaching on the dignity of life. If you have any questions, I would be happy to try to answer them.

We are looking for **volunteers to lead the Rosary** before the weekend Masses and money counters at St Catherine's. If you are willing to help out, please call Rita in the parish office.

I have the details finalized regarding the **Pilgrimage to West Bend, Iowa on Tuesday, June 19th**. We will be leaving the St. Catherine's parking lot at 7:30 am, arriving at the shrine for a 10 am tour, followed by Mass together at the parish church in West Bend, and lunch, stopping at a POW Museum briefly where during World War II, German prisoners of war were held, and stopping briefly on the way back to see two beautifully decorated churches, St. Cecilia in Algona, IA, and St. John's in Bancroft, IA. We have a coach bus reserved that can hold 50. A number of people have signed up already, so if you want to go, call soon. After the bus is full, we will make a waiting list, and if we have enough interest, we can take another bus. Please call Rita in the parish office at St. Catherine's to sign up. It is open to anyone who would like to come. We are asking for a donation of \$50 per person to cover the cost of the bus and lunch in West Bend after our tour of the Grotto. (Depending on how the afternoon goes, we may stop on the way home for people to get something for dinner in the evening for those who are interested.) Hopefully will be back around 6-7 pm.

This next Wednesday, there is an **additional Mass scheduled at St. Catherine's at 11 am that will have the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick**. The parish CCW is offering a lunch after this Mass, but you have to sign up on the sheet in the gathering space or call the parish office, so they know how many to prepare for. It is open to anyone, not just members of St. Catherine's or St. John's.

The **annual volunteer appreciation meals for St Catherine's and St. John's** have now been scheduled. The St. Catherine's appreciation will be on Wednesday June 13th in Rademacher Hall, following a 5:15 pm Mass. The St. John's volunteer appreciation will be on Thursday June 7th. Invitations will be sent out to volunteers – catechists, liturgical ministries, members of committees, etc. But if you somehow got overlooked, give us a call. We want everyone to know how much we appreciate our volunteers, there is so much that gets done "behind the scenes."

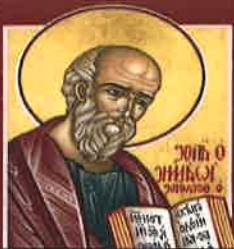
