The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Corpus Christi June 3, 2018



From Fr. Steffl:

This week we celebrate the beautiful Feast of the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus**, the Holy Eucharist. Each year this Feast is a special reminder of the truly great Gift of the Eucharist, Jesus' Body and Blood. We often take this for granted, or don't consider just how important this is to us and our salvation. Some of the hymns and prayers we use for this Feast day (and for Benediction) and the Sequence at Mass were written many centuries ago by St. Thomas Aquinas, who wrote of the Eucharist so beautifully as the "Bread of Angels." We have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every Thursday at St. Catherine's from 9 am – 6 pm. *I extend the invitation to everyone to stop each Thursday, even if it is for just a few minutes of time before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament every week on Thursday, the day Jesus gave us the Blessed Sacrament.*



Connected to the Eucharist is the priesthood, and the **importance that we continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.** The Holy Hour today, Sunday June 3rd, from 4 pm – 5pm will be especially for vocations from our parishes. It has been my fervent prayer that our parishes could provide for the good of the Church Universal, and the Diocese by providing vocations. The prayer for vocations in the blue Breaking Bread book covers catches well our prayer for those who are able to respond generously when they hear Jesus call them to this life.

I have commented in the past, but it bears repeating – it is **great to have so many who come to one or all of the weekday Masses we have in our parishes.** As we think of Corpus Christi, it is amazing to think that we can receive the Lord in the Holy Eucharist, not only once in our lives, or even just every Sunday, but every day. It is a chance also to invite everyone who is not already coming to weekday Masses, to take advantage of this great opportunity. Often people begin going to daily Mass during Lent and continue going, even after Lent is over. We have a good percentage of the parish who goes to daily Mass, but there could be even more! Think of how this can help us grow closer to Jesus and help us bring others to Him!

June is the **month that the Church dedicates to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.** Friday June 8th is the Feast of the Sacred Heart, which always falls on the Friday after Corpus Christi on the Church calendar. At the end of Mass during the month of June, we will conclude with the Litany of the Sacred Heart, as we did during May with the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This last week, St Catherine's made its annual contribution to assist the **neighboring Catholic Schools** that provide for the education of a number of students from our parishes. From our parishes, we have children that go to St Mary's School in Sleepy Eye, St. Michael's School in Morgan, St. Anne's School in Wabasso, and St. Mary's School in Bird Island. Although our parishes here do not have their own Catholic School, I am glad that we are able to provide these opportunities for these students through neighboring Catholic schools, and continue to encourage parents to consider these schools as options.

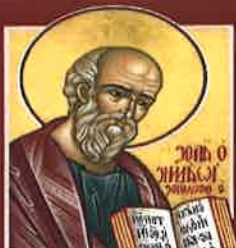
