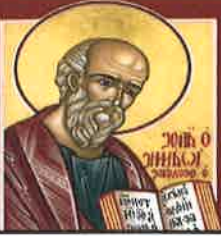
“Mission Cooperative Appeal”

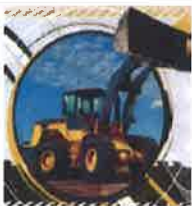
