24th Sunday in Ordinary Time September 16, 2018



From Fr. Tony Hesse:

This past Thursday's Gospel was fitting in light to all the anger, name calling, fighting I am seeing with our government, views of the Church, and people even in our communities and parishes. Instead of finding wanting to retaliate when someone has hurt us or offended us we need to do what Jesus told us in this Gospel. "Be merciful, just as also your Father is merciful. Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven" (Lk 6:36-37). In light of anger, which we all have shown at some time, I like to share this homily I found from one of Fr. Rick Andrew sermons (a priest from St. George Greek Orthodox Church in St. Paul, MN).

King David wrote in the Psalms "Refrain from anger; abandon wrath; do not be provoked; it brings only harm" (37:8). St. Paul picks up David's words in his letter to the Christians in Ephesus and says the following: "Therefore, putting away falsehood, speak the truth, each one to his neighbor, for we are members one of another. Be angry but do not sin; do not let the sun set on your anger, and do not leave room for the devil... And do not grieve the holy Spirit of God, with which you were sealed for the day of redemption. All bitterness, fury, anger, shouting, and reviling must be removed from you, along with all malice. [And] be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ" (4:25-27, 29-32).

So we see that anger does have a place but it must be expressed in a manner that is not sinful. Many of us are familiar with the mechanism of counting to ten when we are angry. The idea is that after ten seconds our anger will subside and then we can deal calmly with whatever is causing the anger to rise within us. During those ten long seconds, we should ask ourselves a few questions. How we answer will help guide us to handling the anger appropriately. First, will my expression of anger make things better or worse? Is the person in front of me the person I'm really and truly angry with or is it someone else? Is the anger, I am feeling inside congruent with the situation? In other words, am I making a mountain out of a molehill? Perhaps, more often than not, it would be best to hold back our anger until we figure out what is going on inside of us. Listen to some wise advice from the Book of Proverbs: "It is good sense to be slow to anger, and an honor to overlook an offense" (19:11). "Do not be friendly with hotheads, nor associate with the wrathful" (22:24). "Fools give vent to all their anger; but the wise, biding their time, control it" (29:11).

One of the main reasons we should be slow to anger is that God Himself is very patient and long-suffering towards us. Being slow to anger is fulfilling the image and likeness of God within us. The Apostle James says, "Know this, my dear brothers: everyone should be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath, for the wrath of a man does not accomplish the righteousness of God" (1:19-20).

Finally, let me close with a passage from the Book of Sirach. "Remember the commandments and do not be angry with your neighbor; remember the covenant of the Most High, and overlook faults. Avoid strife and your sins will be fewer, for the hot-tempered kindle strife; The sinner disrupts friendships and sows discord among those who are at peace" (28:7-9). My brothers and sisters in Christ, let us bring friendliness and godliness into all our relationships, even when we are angry with each other. Peace be with all! Amen!

Discipleship Day 2018

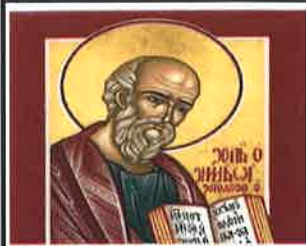

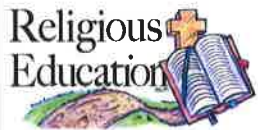
