# 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time September 23, 2018



From: Fr. Tony Hesse:

This past Tuesday, Fr. James Adams spoke to a number of us priests who gathered for our periodic priest recollection gathering. As you know, our Church has been devastated by the clergy abuse and the handling of the abuses by various Church leaders. I can't imagine what the victims and their families are going through, or even you as God's people who had put your trust in your priests. However, as he told us, and I am telling you, don't be discouraged.

To be discouraged, means a person is going backwards. To encourage, means we go forward. That is what we need to do here. We need to be encouraged and not discouraged. For example, the disciples on the road to Emmaus were saddened and confused because of Jesus' terrible death on the cross. They were hoping for something great from Him and they felt their hope was shattered by His crucifixion...until Christ encountered them on the road and met them where they were at. After He opened their eyes to Him to them in the breaking of the bread and all that scriptures mentioned about Him, they turned around and went back to Jerusalem filled with hope and trust. That is what we need to do during this difficult time in the Church, or whenever we face difficulties (for example, all the rain that we are experiencing).

Every day, we are going into battle with the evil one who wants to knock us down and get us discouraged. But we must not go backwards to Emmaus, but we must be encouraged by Christ and go forward to Jerusalem. We need to also be hopeful and put our trust in Him. As St. Paul writes to the Ephesians, "Finally, draw your strength from the Lord and from his mighty power. Put on the armor of God so that you may be able to stand firm against the tactics of the devil. For our struggle is not with flesh and blood but with the principalities, with the powers, with the world rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the heavens. Therefore, put on the armor of God, that you may be able to resist on the evil day and, having done everything, to hold your ground. So stand fast with your loins girded in truth, clothed with righteousness as a breastplate, and your feet shod in readiness for the gospel of peace. In all circumstances, hold faith as a shield, to quench all [the] flaming arrows of the evil one. And take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. With all prayer and supplication, pray at every opportunity in the Spirit." (Eph 6:10-18a)

Our swords are the cross of Christ. As we go into battle against evil, and continue to defend our Church, going back to Jerusalem also means going to the cross. Fighting for the Church, for our Lord, for our faith, means using the cross as our sword and not giving up. Remember, Jesus has already won the war. We just have to let Him help us through our daily battles. Know that my continued prayers are for all of you and Holy Mother Church. For 2,000 years, our Church has gone through battles before, and sadly, I guarantee, we will go through a lot more. May Christ continue to go before us and may we not be discouraged and go backwards, but with His help, be encouraged and move forward to Jerusalem.

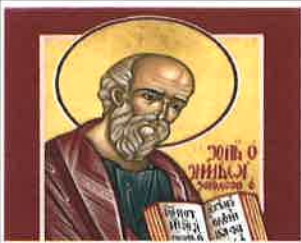

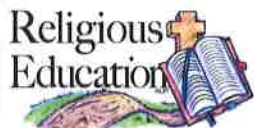
