From: Fr. Tony Hesse:

We had an excellent Area Worship & Spiritual Life Committee Meeting this past Monday. Normally, I am trying to avoid having meetings on Monday, but I wanted to begin discussion on things from our area regarding worship and spiritual life. On a side note, we have had an Area Pastoral Council, Joint Administrative Council, Evangelization & Catechesis Committee meetings so far, and I am looking at having a Mass with all the CCW officers and members on Tuesday, October 2, beginning with Mass at 6 PM at St. Catherine's (all parishioners from our area are invited for the Mass and all women from our area are invited to the meeting afterward). Finally, on October 18th, we will be having an Area Social Concerns Committee. If anyone from St. John's or the Light of the World AFC is interested in joining or learning more, please come to the meeting. It will be at St. Catherine's at 6:30 PM.

Now, let us go back to the Worship and Spiritual Life Committee discussion. We have been asked to host a Rosary Congress in our area in a couple of weeks. In a nutshell, the bishop has asked that several different parishes host 24 hours devoted to praying the rosary each hour, adoration, and Mass. Because of our school, the diocesan office asked if we could have it at St. Anne's. More information will come out soon, as well as, needing people to sign up.

We also discussed the number of adoration availability. Our parishes are blessed to have a number of opportunities for adoration. We will continue Thursdays at St. Catherine's, Saturday mornings at St. Anne's, Sunday evenings at St. Catherine's, and the 3rd Wednesdays at Our Lady. There will be opportunity for special adorations throughout the year (example, see the Rosary Congress above). We will discontinue 1st Friday adoration and adoration before the last weekend Masses for Light of the World AFC. Also, there will be prayers of reparation for the sex abuse that can be used during adoration times. By the way, please come during any of these times to spend some time with our Lord. I hope to say more and continue to encourage this powerful time with Christ in future columns.

Speaking of adoration, we will also be starting offering the Precious Blood at all weekend and weekday Masses at St. Catherine's and St. John's. "Since the celebration of the Eucharist is the Paschal Banquet, it is desirable that in accordance with the Lord's command his Body and Blood should be received as spiritual food by those of the faithful who are properly disposed" (General Instruction of the Roman Missal no. 80). Although many priests discontinue offering the Precious Blood for fear that it might be spilled, I want to offer it at all the Masses. With that being said, we are in need of people to help with this ministry and exposing and reposing the Blessed Sacrament at adoration and to bring Holy Communion to the homebound and nursing homes. Therefore, please pray and ask if our Lord is asking you to help with these ministries. I am hoping to write a letter soon to Bishop LeVoir so that you can be recognized by him and commissioned for these ministries.

Not only do we see our Lord present in Holy Communion, but also in the Anointing of the Sick. Eventually, I will share more about the anointing, but for now, please join us for this sacrament during the nursing home Masses throughout this month and also the last week of the month, October 23-26. If any of the parishes want to do some reception of some sort afterwards, please let our parish offices know.

Also, you will be seeing the presider's chairs and the deacon's chairs moved further ahead. One, I don't like sitting back so far or off to the side. Secondly, I want to show the importance of the chair, along with the altar and the ambo. The altar signifies the sacrifice of Christ; the ambo signifies where Holy Scripture is proclaimed; and the presider's chair signifies the gathered community in prayer. "The chair of the Priest Celebrant must signify his function of presiding over the gathering and of directing the prayer. Thus the more suitable place for the chair is facing the people at the head of the sanctuary... The seat for the Deacon should be placed near that of the celebrant" (GIRM, no. 310)

Finally, we will be offering confessions a half hour or so before all weekday Masses, before the 5 PM Saturday Masses, before 8 AM Sunday morning Masses and on Saturday mornings (as already scheduled). God's mercy can never be contained and He truly wants to celebrate it with you. Hopefully, these times will offer those opportunities.

More was shared at that meeting, but I figure I will give you a breather. Stay tuned for more info next weekend...

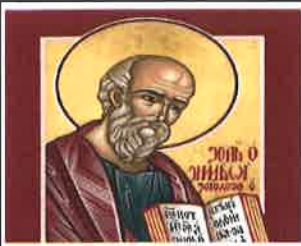

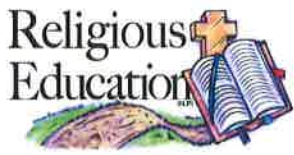

Blood Power Red - Hide

Blood: The most common type of donation, during which approximately a pint of 'whole blood' is given. This type of blood donation usually takes about an hour.

Power Red: A Power Red donation collects the red cells but returns most of the plasma and platelets to the donor. These donors must meet specific eligibility requirements and have type A Neg, B Neg, or O blood.
