From Fr. Tony Hesse:

Hopefully you are able to look beyond the mistakes and get the gist idea out of my poorly written column. Perhaps, see it as a game, like "Word Find", and try to count the number of mistakes. Just don't tell me.

As I mentioned last week, not only did we meet our Marathon goal at St. Anne's of \$23,000 set for our students, but now we also reached our budgeted goal by collecting \$25,045.86. This weekend, in the petitions at the St. Anne's Mass, we will be bringing the prayer intentions that our students collected forward and offer them up to our Lord. God truly is generous, and I thank all of you for supporting St. Anne's and area Catholic schools.

Speaking of kids, if you want your child's costume blessed before they go trick-or-treating in it, please bring it to the weekend Masses next weekend. As long as it is not contrary to the faith or grotesque, Deacon, Fr. Bob, or I would love to pray over their costume to keep them safe.

When it comes to blessing, the sacraments are the greatest of blessings. Please come and celebrate the sacrament of the sick at the weekday Masses in our parishes. "When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age." (from the www.usccb.org)

Those who can be anointed are:

- those who are dangerously ill through sickness or old age
- a sick person...before surgery, whenever the surgery is necessitated by a dangerous illness
- elderly people...if they are weak, though not dangerously ill
- sick children...sufficiently mature to be comforted by the sacrament
- sick people who have lost consciousness or who have lost the use of reason...if ...they would have requested it if they had been in possession of their faculties

Speaking of blessing, please use the insert blurb on the rosary to help let Our Lady of the Rosary know what is on your heart. Just today, my sister-in-law asked me to pray for my nephew who had a concussion playing football recently. Yes, I most certainly will pray for him, but who better to ask for prayer, than our Mother Mary. Also, join us for the Living Rosary at St. Catherine's this Wednesday at 7:30pm. Although I mentioned it in the announcements, I didn't encourage our parishioners enough to attend. We had no one show up other than the students and teachers, and so I want to do better to encourage you all to come. Like we did at St. Anne's, and will be doing this Wednesday at St. Catherine's, we will have the lights off and we will be using lit up balloons to pray the prayers. There are some great reflections and scriptures that will accompany the rosary. Again, please join us for the Living Rosary at St. Catherine's at 7:30pm this Wednesday, October 24th, and let our Mother Mary know your intentions. By the way, thanks to all who helped with the Rosary Congress this past week at St. Anne's. It was a beautiful and very powerful 24 hours in our AFC. May our area reap the benefits from all the prayers.

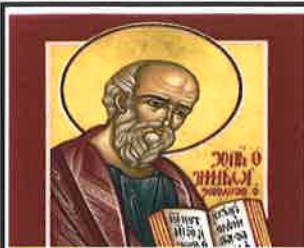

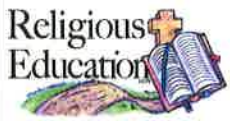

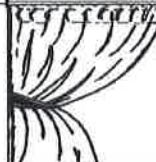
