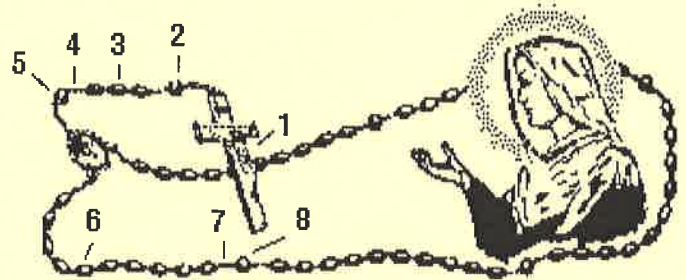

1. Make the **Sign of the Cross** and say the "Apostles' Creed."
2. Say the "Our Father."
3. Say three "Hail Mary's."
4. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
5. Announce the First Mystery; then say the "Our Father."
6. Say ten "Hail Mary's," while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
8. Announce the Second Mystery; then say the "Our Father." Repeat 6 and 7 and continue with Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
9. After the final decade, "Glory Be", and "Fatima Prayer", pray the "Hail Holy Queen" and conclude with the "Rosary Prayer" [*Let us pray, O God, whose only begotten Son, by His life death and Resurrection, has purchased for us the reward of eternal salvation. Grant we beseech Thee, that while meditating upon these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.*]
10. Conclude with the **Sign of the Cross**.



(After each of the "Glory Be's", please add the "Fatima Prayer" "*Oh my Jesus, forgive us our sins. Save us from the fires of hell and lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are in need of your mercy.*" You can also pray the prayer from Archbishop Sheen, "*Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of [baby's name] the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion.*")

The Cycle of the Rosary

As suggested by the Holy Father (since 2002) the Joyful mysteries are said on Monday and Saturday, the Luminous on Thursday, the Sorrowful on Tuesday and Friday, and the Glorious on Wednesday and Sunday (with this exception: Sundays of Christmas season - The Joyful; Sundays of Lent - Sorrowful)

The Rosary can help us unite our suffering and frustration to Mary who experienced the same feeling as she saw her Son hanging on the cross, or our joyful moments to the times when she also experienced great joy. Please pray that God's will be done, like Mary did. Evil is so real in our world and the Rosary is a powerful tool to battle against the evil, especially abortion. Please join me as we pray for peace, grace, life, and Our Lady of the Rosary's protection.
