From: Fr. Tony Hesse:

Last week I mentioned several things that were discussed at our last Area Worship and Spiritual Life Committee meeting. Although I know there has been a lot going on in our parishes, please join me and our Area Pastoral Council as we discern a name for our parishes. In order to truly be an Area Faith Community (AFC), we need a name. We can either keep the name that the southern parishes have for all 6 parishes and be called Light of the World AFC, or we can come up with a new name. However, if we are changing our name, we will need to come up with several options and reasons for those options, and then the Bishop will take those options and prayerfully discern our name. If you have any options, please let me know and your reasons for that name. It was also discussed that there might be a prize for the name that was chosen and selected, that is, if we end up selecting a new name.

I also like to look at getting mentor couples to help with marriage preparation. Basically, these couples would meet with engaged couples to go over the communication inventory, "the test", and offer assistance in communication. Not only would the engaged couple benefit from the mentor couple's wisdom and experience, but I believe the mentor couple also would walk away with some helpful information for their own marriages. At least, that is what my parents and my brother and sister-in-law said, who are also mentor couples in their parishes. If you are ever interested in finding out more information or would like to volunteer you and your spouse (you might want to ask him/her first), please let me know.

Speaking of marriages, our committee also decided to allow for couples to schedule their weddings as late as 3:00pm on Saturdays. For some of our 6 parishes this has already been the case. Many couples want to have the weddings as late as possible so it was closer to the meal. Although this will shorten our 4:00 confessions on Saturday night at St. Catherine's to 4:30, we hope to have more confessions available before all the weekday Masses as well. Know that you can also call for an appointment, if you would ever like to celebrate reconciliation.

Also, please help yourself to the Litany of Humility and the Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel (back-to-back) prayer cards that are in the entrances of all the churches. Last weekend, I preached about the jealousy in the readings and encouraged the Litany to help to be humble and to put other's first. I try to work at this wonderful virtue and encourage you to join me and also ask for St. Michael's protection from the evil of jealousy.

Finally, we have finished our last church festival last week at St. Anne's. Thanks to all who went out of their way these last four weeks to meet prior to these festival and dinners, to those who took the time and helped out and showed up for your time to work, especially for those who even stayed longer to help out, and to all who attended. I love seeing parishioners come together (especially from different parts of our AFC), work together, and even eat together...and especially pray together. Please continue to pray for each other and our area faith community. Know that you are all in mine.

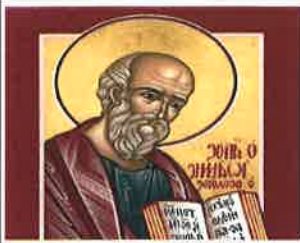

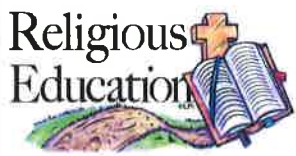
