# 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time October 28, 2018



From: Fr. Tony Hesse:

As you notice in the bulletin, we are now offering classes for baptism. If you are expecting or know of someone who is expecting, they will need to sign up for classes. *We are asking that all new families with children and families with several children sign up for this class. We are also asking that from here on out, that if it has been three years since you had gone to class, and are expecting again, that you take this class. It is about an hour long.* Therefore, when you call to line up the baptismal date, again know that Fr. Bob, Fr. Christian (who will be our new priest in a few weeks from Nigeria and I'll share more about him next week), Deacon Ryan, and I are available to celebrate this important day with you, your family, and the Church. If you have questions, please let Deacon Ryan or myself know. Thanks

Also, please join us, again, on Monday nights at 7pm at St. Catherine's and Tuesday nights at 7pm at St. Anne's for Bishop Baron's series called, "The Mass". I heard that both sessions this past week were great and covered a lot about this wonderful mystery of faith. If you have children and need childcare, please call the parish office so we can line it up. Thanks. Also Bishop Baron has a great and truthful response to the abuse and how we should handle it, not as an institution, but as a people of God, with Christ as our Good Shepherd. Finally, as we continue to live out our Baptismal call to holiness, and are strengthened by our Lord in the Eucharist, please know that the Church has been given several people throughout her history to intercede for us. Not only will we be celebrating them this week (reminder: All Saints is this Thursday and it is a holy day of obligation – Mass times are in the bulletin), but we can also call upon the prayers of the seven newest ones to be canonized. As we ask for their prayers, please keep the souls of purgatory in your prayers as well. Join our parishes and families who have lost loved ones, especially this past year, for special All Soul's day Masses on November 2. Mass times and places are in the bulletin. And remember to ask for the newest saints below to intercede for you and our loved ones who have died.

**Blessed Pope Paul VI (d. 1978)** was pope from 1963-1978 and continued Vatican II. Paul VI is perhaps most noted for his 1968 encyclical *Humanae Vitae*, which served as the Church's official rebuke to artificial contraception, prohibiting its use.

**Blessed Oscar Romero (d. 1980)** was an Archbishop who was an outspoken defender of the rights of the poor in El Salvador, who were being terrorized by right-wing military death squads mainly because of protests over the extreme economic inequality in the country in the 20th century. Romero was assassinated, likely by a right-wing death squad, while celebrating Mass.

**Blessed Vincent Romano (d. 1831)**, priest, developed a devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, and known for his simple ways and his care for orphans. He worked to rebuild his parish, often with his bare hands, after the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 1794.

**Blessed Francesco Spinelli (d. 1913)**, priest, educated the poor and also served as a seminary professor, spiritual director, and counselor for several women's religious communities, and founder of the Institute of the Adorers of the Blessed Sacrament. The sisters dedicated themselves to Eucharistic adoration day and night, which inspired their service to the poor and suffering.

**Blessed Nunzio Sulprizio (d. 1836)**, lost both of his parents at age six and was brought up by an uncle who exploited him for hard labor. Fatigued and often given dangerous assignments, he developed gangrene and eventually lost his leg. Despite his tremendous suffering, he would reportedly make statements such as: "Jesus suffered a lot for me. Why should I not suffer for Him? I would die in order to convert even one sinner." He recovered from the gangrene and dedicated himself to helping other patients before his health deteriorated again and died at 19 years old.

**Blessed Nazaria Ignacia March Mesa (d. 1943)** entered the Franciscan Third Order, moved to Mexico in 1904, and joined the Institute of Sisters of the Abandoned Elders, who inspired her to join their order. Later she felt a call to found a new order dedicated to missionary work, and founded the Pontifical Crusade, later renamed the Congregation of the Missionary Crusaders of the Church, with the mission to catechize children and adults, support the work of priests, conduct missions, and to print and distribute short religious tracts.

**Blessed Maria Katharina Kasper (d. 1898)** attended very little school because of poor health. Despite this, she began to help the poor, the abandoned, and the sick at a young age, even her own parents. She and four other women officially took vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience and formed the Poor Handmaids of Jesus Christ. ....All you saints of God, pray for us.

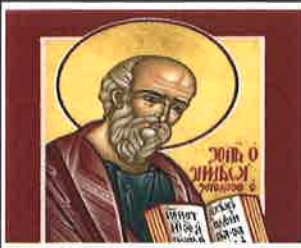

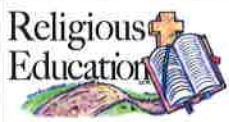
