From Fr. Tony Hesse:

In the bulletins these last couple of weeks, I shared about things that were happening in our area faith community. I know that someone of you may feel that we are moving too fast with this “area thing”. However, our parishes are blessed with so many events and committees, that it makes it difficult to make it to them all if we don’t combine some of them. I want to make sure that I can make it to all the meetings, cover all the material that needs to be covered, and make it to as many of the sporting events as I can (i.e. tennis, football, volleyball, and cross country). I love sports and I love to show my support to the youth hoping that they feel that they are very much an important part of our parishes. I hope to keep trying to make it to as many as I can at all age levels.

For example, I was very please and happy that St. Anne’s reached the goal we had for the kids of \$23,000. Nice job kids and thanks parents, family, friends, and supporters of our school. Although we budgeted \$25,000, it was lowered because of the concern we have for our farmers during this difficult harvest. If you would still like to support us at St Anne’s School (or any of our Catholic schools in our area), please let us know at any of the parish or school offices. If you have any questions or concerns, I would love to listen to them regarding the donations or direction of the parishes. I want to be there for you and know that I care for you. And speaking of being there for you, several weeks ago, our Bishop went on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. I want to share how he thought about our diocese and prayed for us throughout this pilgrimage:

“We are now in Jordan on the last leg of our pilgrimage in the Holy Land. It has been a richly and profoundly blessed experience for us all. In the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem, there are stairs leading up to an upper level of the church. There one finds an altar built over the place where Jesus was crucified. Under the altar is an oval opening in the floor. One is able to kneel and go under the altar to venerate the place where the cross of Christ once stood.

As an important part of my pilgrimage, I knelt, moved forward on my knees, kissed the place of the crucifixion, and placed my hand on the very ground of Golgotha. As I did, I prayed for the healing of the profound wounds inflicted on the victims and survivors of sexual abuse by clergy. I asked forgiveness for the bishops who did not act to stop such abuse. I prayed for the healing of the wounds caused by sexual abuse by clergy on the Church, the Body of Christ, and on the Diocese of New Ulm. The scripture verse that kept coming into my mind as I prayed was: "By His wounds we were healed" (Is 53:5).

We then moved from Golgotha, down the stairs, to the empty tomb of Christ which is housed in the same Church of the Holy Sepulchre. I celebrated Mass deep inside the tomb on an altar constructed over the place where Jesus' dead body was placed after the crucifixion and from which He rose from the dead. I kissed this place and prayed that the Resurrection of Jesus would heal all of the terrible wounds of sexual abuse by clergy suffered by so many. I have heard that many from the diocese joined me on this pilgrimage in solidarity by uniting their prayer, fasting, and penance with my prayer, fasting, and penance. I am most grateful.”

Please keep our Bishop in your prayers. 10 years ago, he was ordained for our diocese. I guarantee he never thought he would have to deal with everything that he is dealing with, like the sex abuse, bankruptcy, priest and people shortage, merging and closing of parishes. As he celebrates his 10th anniversary, along with all the other challenges, please continue to keep him in your prayers. 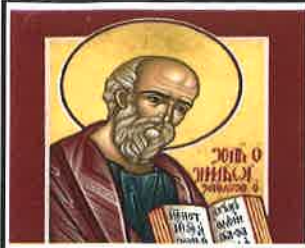

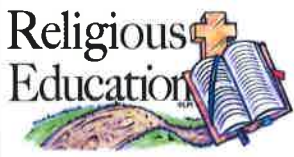
