Third Sunday of Advent December 16, 2018



From Fr. Tony Hesse:

As some of you heard, Fr. Christian did get his drivers permit. Although he can drive in Nigeria, now he has to get used to driving with all of our rules and laws in America. He has been looking at cars, but was wondering if someone from our parishes has a car that he could buy from them. With the income that he makes, he will be looking at a used, reliable car. If anyone has one for sale, please let us know at the parish offices.

Also, please let us know at the parish offices if you are interested on getting on the list to help lector (read), usher/greeter, serve, cantor and musician, and be an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion (this ministry needs to be commissioned by the Bishop) at any of the Masses in our Area Faith Community (AFC). By the way, you can be commissioned for giving out Holy Communion during Mass, outside of Mass to the nursing homes and homes, and assist with adoration. I hope to have a couple of gatherings in January to get us all on the same page on these ministries (both current ministers and new ministers). If you are not ministering very often or ministering too often already, please let me also know.

Thirdly, please let us know at the parish offices if you or if you know of someone who is sick at home or now lives in a nursing home or an assisted living home (that is outside of our AFC) and would like a visit. We will try (keep in mind I said the word, "try") to stop in and visit, offer any sacraments that you want, and share some Advent joy. I don't want to assume that people want visitors. Therefore, if we have not visited, it is not that we don't care, we just want parishioners to let us know and not assume. We want to visit, we just want to also respect people's privacy.

And speaking of visiting, as we celebrate the greatest visit ever on earth, the birth of Jesus in our world, please feel free to bring your baby Jesus statues and figurines from your nativity sets to have them blessed at the weekend Masses next weekend (Dec. 22-23). At some point during Mass we will have you hold them up to be blessed.

Finally, as Jesus comes to us, please take the time this week to come to Him in the sacrament of reconciliation. Please refer to the confession times to experience forgiveness and healing from our Lord. By the way, I did change the time of one of the places (on Dec. 23rd St. Mary's in Seaforth is also at 11:00am and *not* 10:30am).

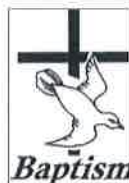

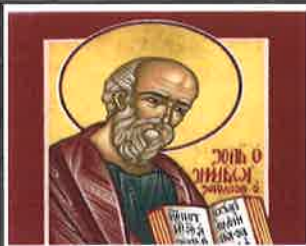

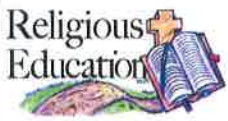
YOU ARE INVITED:
