Fourth Sunday of Advent December 23, 2018



"I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly" (Jn 10:10). What better way to have a more abundant life, than to have it in Christ. As we count our blessings this time of year, we can also see how abundant those blessings are. Christ and His love is the greatest gift and blessing we will ever receive, and He gives it abundantly. Not only do we celebrate this abundant blessing by His incarnation (His birth), but especially by His passion, death, and resurrection (the Pascal Mystery). In a few weeks, our diocese will have an opportunity to celebrate the Pascal Mystery through a retreat.

TEC (Together Encounter Christ) is a three-day retreat and experience designed for people who are searching for goals, acceptance, meaning, community, values, and most especially, for God – or deepen their relationship with God. A TEC Retreat is a spiritual encounter around the Pascal Mystery and is intended for people who are 16 and older. It is a weekend of fun, food and faith that may be just what you're looking for. Our next retreat is January 19-21 at Holy Redeemer in Marshall. Please sign up by January 1. We will also have a second weekend February 16-18 at Holy Trinity in Winsted. Please sign up by January 25 for this weekend. Our final weekend is June 22-24 at St. Mary's in Bird Island. The final sign-up date is June 1. Please join us for this great encounter with Christ! Also, I hope you enjoyed the thought provoking letter a parishioner gave me that is attached to the bulletin. It made me think how I can have a more abundant life. Am I going to be part of the problem or part of the solution? Thanks to all who work at being part of the solution, all who work and volunteer their time for our parishes and our school. Thanks also to the individual who donated \$200 for our youth Pizza with Padres program as well as a family who received a recent estate gift and wanted to share a portion of their gift with our school. They gave \$7,000 for school maintenance. As we near the end of the year, feel free to consider gifting something to our parishes or school. Not only does it support us to continue the faith, but it also can help with your taxes. Truly, our blessings are abundant in our area faith community.

WHY ARE YOU NOT HAPPY? GOD CREATED YOU TO BE HAPPY

Don't allow anybody or anything to control your happiness. God and yourself are in charge of your life. Happiness starts with you, not with your relationships, not with your job, not with your money, not with your circumstances, but with you. Life is worth living when you are happy. God did not create you to be sad always; though sad moments can punctuate your life, but don't allow such moments to control your whole life.

However, there are things which always open doors for sadness into our lives when we permit them.

1) Jealousy can keep one unhappy for the rest of his/her life when it is not checkmated. Jealousy leads to slander which is not the will of God and should not be seen among the children of God. This is the advice to we Christians: "Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it but sitting in judgment on it" (James 4:11). Always thank God for what another person has which you don't have and also thank God for what you have which other person don't have. Either you are black or fair in complexion or short or tall in height, beautiful/handsome or ugly, rich or poor, etcetera. They are all gifts which should always be appreciated and cherished. You don't need to be jealous; there are things which you have or can do which the other person don't have or can't do.

2) Problems of life are meant to bring us closer to God. Greater number of people go to church or pray because of their problem, that is why Karl Marx defined Religion as the opium of the people. Bartimaeus called upon Jesus Christ to have pity on him because he was blind and believed that Jesus will heal him. (Mark 10:-46-52) Let your problems draw you closer to Jesus as Bartimaeus blindness drew him closer to Jesus. Jesus is always calling us to come and stay in His Eucharistic Presence in the Holy Hour/Adoration we have in our parishes. The secret of my happiness lies in relaxing or telling God my problems, worries, challenges, and difficulties in the Eucharistic presence. Stop complaining about the troubles you have and always thank God for the troubles you don't have.

3) Some people are unhappy because of their addictions or sins, but it shouldn't be. Believe you can overcome your addictions and habitual sins. Jesus Christ is ever ready to assist you overcome your worries if only you listen and obey Him as He speaks to you in the Gospels and through His priests or ministers and agents. Remember what Jesus said in His Gospel according to Luke 19:10; "For the son of man has come to seek and save what was lost." Stop preventing God from doing His work; He wants you to come to Him with your sins and addictions so that He will make you better. Why being unhappy because of your sins when you have Jesus Christ who died for your sins (Isaiah 54 & John 1:36)

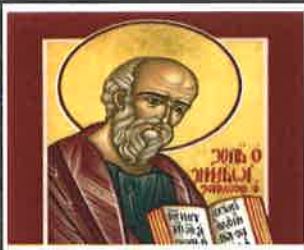
Pro-Life Rally at Capitol: Save the date:

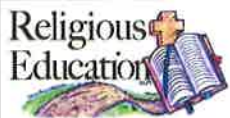
