From: Fr. Tony Hesse:

We have a lot of events coming up in our area. If at all possible, please join us for as many of the events as you can:

1. On January 22, 2019 we will be commemorating the 46th anniversary of Roe v Wade as a day of prayer and witness to the sanctity of all human life. On Sunday, January 27th at 4pm, please join us and our area churches in the northern half at St. Catherine's for an ecumenical prayer service praying for life and healing. There will be a potluck to follow. Please join us and bring a dish to pass, or at least join us for the prayer service. (Don't feel obligated to bring a dish though either).
2. Also, Bishop John LeVoir has granted a partial indulgence to all who attend the Cathedral Prayer Service and March for Life in St. Paul on Tuesday the 29th, to pray for the culture of life. See the Family Life page at dnu.org for further information about the indulgence. The pilgrimage will start at 6:45 am from the Northwest corner of the Market Street Mall Parking Lot in Marshall and will stop at St. Catherine's in Redwood Falls. People are invited to join the pilgrimage and ride the bus. The bus is sponsored by area Council of Catholic Women and Knights of Columbus. The Prayer Service for Life is at the Cathedral of St. Paul at 10:30 am and then participants can ride the bus or walk to the public rally at the Capitol at noon. The bus will return after the rally. Dress warm and bring a sack lunch. To reserve a seat on the bus please contact Lori Timmerman at (507) 476-0070 or ltimmerman@holy-redeemer.com. Bishop John LeVoir invites everyone to join him on the pilgrimage, either in St. Paul or commemorating it at home or at work. Let's make it a day of prayer and sacrifice for the spread of the culture of life.
3. This past Friday, we began the annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity and it concludes this Friday. We included in the bulletin daily prayer guides to help you throughout this week. Sorry about being a few days late. After this week, please continue to remember this year's theme: "Justice, Only Justice, You Shall Pursue" (Deuteronomy 16:20) and pray "that all may be one... that the world may believe" (John 17:21). Next week, Tuesday, January 29th at 7pm, we will be joining our southern area churches at St. Anne's for our ecumenical prayer service praying for this unity. There will be a little reception to follow. Please join us as we pray that we all may be one.
4. If you have not filled out our stewardship and informational forms, please do so as soon as you can. They are in the back of the churches if you have not received one yet. We are hoping to gather the information and create a booklet with all the ministries, councils/committees, and an overview of our finances soon. We would like the forms due by noon, February 1.
5. Next week, we will be celebrating Catholic Schools Week. Catholic schools are good because they are known for providing a social and supportive atmosphere that is conducive to learning and personal growth. They are famous for graduating a disproportionately high number of academically successful students. They favor a personal development model that encourages students to pursue independent interests while maintaining high test scores. Catholic schools are well-known for having strict disciplinary policies. Catholic schools still maintain religious education programs, which involve prayer, confession and church service.

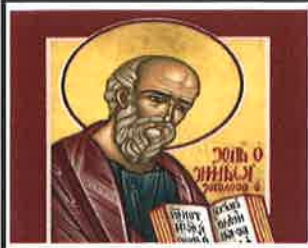
Pro-Life Rally at Capitol:
