From: Fr. Tony Hesse:

What a blessing it has been for me to see the six parishes in our AFC working together and representing their respective parishes on the different councils and committees. From a document from the diocesan office, and with the help of Katie Prokosch formulating and reworking that document, I would like to share this information. As we are joining our 6 parishes together, we are becoming one Area Faith Community (or AFC) and we need a new name. It is important that we have one common name, as we join together our resources and our community into one brand new Area Faith Community. Although it would be fun to just choose whichever name we like, there are guidelines that must be followed. When choosing a new name, the name must either be a title of Jesus or named after Mary or the Saints.

Our Diocese of New Ulm has several AFCs and each has a unique name that identifies and represents their community. When a new area is formed, the task to pick a name begins. As ideas for new names are offered as a suggestion it is helpful to have reasoning or an explanation of why that name was suggested and how it represents the community. After names have been submitted to the newly formed AFC councils, three names will be chosen and sent to the Bishop. The Bishop will pray and reflect on the names, and finally he will choose the title of the Area Faith Community. When the names are presented, these procedures should be followed:

1. The Area Pastoral Council must be established and the area must have initiated the Area Faith Community Planning Process a minimum of two years earlier.
2. Three names and a rationale for their selection are submitted by the pastoral leaders and the Area Pastoral Council. Each area may design its own process for selecting the names that will be submitted.
3. The three names and their rationales are submitted to the bishop for his selection of one of the names on the list. A name will be used only one time in the diocese.
4. The bishop will send a letter which officially assigns the name. The date of the letter is the date the area faith community is officially established in the diocese. The area faith community can then begin using the name in conjunction with those ministries, programs, and activities identified with that area faith community.

In other words, this Thursday our AFC Pastoral Council will be looking at names. We will consider keeping the name *Light of the World* for the whole AFC or we will consider the requests that as we start a new AFC, that people also want a new identity to go with it. Some have voiced the thoughts of keeping the name, others have voiced choosing a new one. Here are some examples: **Light of the World** (Lucan, Seaforth, Wabasso, Wanda) ---*can be our name*; **Good Shepherd** (Litchfield-Manannah); **Bread of Life** (Cottonwood-Green Valley-Marshall); **Jesus Our Living Water** (Willmar-Spicer-Kandiyohi-Lake Lillian). Please let us know by noon on Thursday your suggestions and why. Thanks.

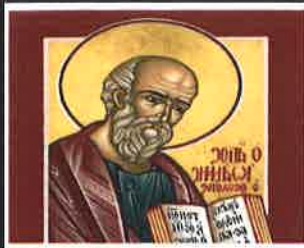

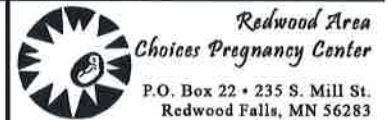
