From: Fr. Tony Hesse:

After our joint Administrative Council Meeting and Area Faith Community (AFC) Pastoral Council Meeting a couple of Thursdays ago, I decided to hold off with choosing a name right now and work at prayerfully discerning what happens next to our parishes as we work toward the possibility of having one priest for our AFC by June 2020. For those of you who submitted names and rationale, thank you. We will keep the suggestions and re-visit the naming of our AFC later in the process.

As I mentioned to some people, I want to apologize for any inconveniences that I might have caused a couple of weeks ago when I combined Masses or cancelled Masses. Again, I was not able to find another priest when I was gone on a retreat, and I cancelled Masses at St. John's and St. Mary's the next weekend because of the snow. Although some people may have been upset, I am sorry. However, we just don't have the priests to cover anymore, nor the people coming to worship. Plus, as I am writing this, they are already forecasting some nasty weather. Again, I will prayerfully discern what to do when there is bad weather. I don't want to cause people who are going out for Mass to get stranded or get in accidents (like the one I preached on this past Ash Wednesday).

Know that you are all in my thoughts and prayers.

Dare to be Different: Stand out Like Noah

“So the LORD said, ‘I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the ground, man and beast and creeping things and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them.’ But Noah found favour in the eyes of the LORD....Then the LORD said to Noah, ‘Go into the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that you are righteous before me in this generation.’” *(Genesis 6:7 - 7:1)*

However, amongst all the men that lived and amongst all the evil that had become so widespread in the surface of the world, one man stood out; one man found favour with God; his name was Noah.

The story of Noah teaches us one lesson: “IF YOU CANNOT BEAT THEM, DO NOT JOIN THEM.” Never commit a sin simply on the basis that “everyone is doing it.” Even if it happened to be true that everyone is doing it, why not become Noah? Why not live according to your conscience rather than follow the crowd?

It must have been difficult for Noah living in such a wicked world; he must have been the laughing stock of some while at the same time attracting to himself the hatred of others all because he was just not like them. But in the end, Noah's difference paid off. He built the ark in obedience to God, saved his life and that of his family as well as the animals that followed him into the ark.

Our society today can be compared to the state of the world in the time of Noah. We hear all kinds of evil that people do, our televisions never seem to get tired of bad news. Evil and immorality have eaten deep into every facet of our society. The Church is not even spared. Government officials can now afford to spread fake news just to score political goals.

One question for you today is: “Would you dare to be different?” Do you plan to live your life following the popular script? Would you rather be the last person standing as far as holiness and Christian morality is concerned? Do not be a copy-cat. Do not do anything simply because so and so is doing it, let your actions be motivated by truth, righteousness and according to the mind of God.

Let us Pray: Lord Jesus, grant me the courage to always stand out for good. Amen.

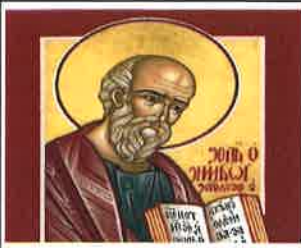
