“Therefore, if you bring your gift to the altar, and there recall that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift” (Mt 5:23-24). These verses were from the Gospel this past Thursday (10th week of ordinary time). Because we celebrated the Memorial of St. Barnabas, I chose the readings that were for the memorial. Those who were watching livestream or attended Mass at St. Anne’s heard a different Gospel. Nonetheless, I thought about this passage and about the Sign of Peace during Mass.

Although some churches and priests are choosing to omit the Sign of Peace, I will still continue it. We may not be able to shake hands or embrace like we would normally do, however, this passage reminds us of the importance to not only ritualize the Sign of Peace, but to also live it out. As we bring our gifts to the altar, as we come receiving our Lord in Holy Communion, we also need to be in unity and at peace with one another, and what better place to celebrate unity, then in the sacrament of reconciliation.

As you notice in the bulletin, we have certain dates and times when we are offering the sacrament of reconciliation. However, if these times don’t work, please call us to schedule an appointment. Right now, because we are asked to have confession in a well-ventilated area, we are not having confessions before Mass. In order to have anonymity and privacy, we are having special areas designated for the sacrament with music playing in the background to block out the conversation behind the screens. This music would have been a distraction for those praying before Mass if we would have confessions then..

Finally, speaking of Mass and unity, please pray for our people of Our Lady of Victory in Lucan, St. Mary in Seaforth, and St. Mathias in Wanda. This coming weekend (June 20-21) we will be having our Last/Closing Masses with no more weekend Masses (please see bulletin for Mass times and places). St. Mary and St. Mathias will be closing and Our Lady of Victory will be merging (meaning they can have weekday Masses and weddings and funerals). St. Mary and St. Mathias are in the process of either selling or tearing down their churches. Words cannot say how much my heart goes out to them during this very difficult time. Together in unity, we pray for you, welcome you, and walk with you on this painful journey.

For those of you from St. Anne and St. Catherine, your Mass times will also be different. Not only did we tweak the Mass schedule that same weekend to accommodate Fr. Bob Mraz who will be celebrating those Masses (please see bulletin), but we also are getting prepared for the new Mass schedule beginning June 27-28. Beginning that weekend, we will have Mass at 4pm at St. Catherine, 6pm at St. Anne on Saturday and 8am at St. Catherine and 10am at St. Anne on Sunday. The reason for these times and places is because there is usually an older crowd on Saturday nights at St. Catherine’s, so we are hoping they would not mind having Mass earlier. Being nobody likes a 7pm Mass on Saturday we moved that first Mass earlier. On Sunday, many people from St. Catherine and St. John preferred the earlier Mass time, so we schedule the 8am at St. Catherine, and being St. Anne was used to having the 10am, we would have them have the 10am. We are going to try this for the next 3 months (July-September) and see how this goes. If we have to rotate Masses, I’m fine with this, but please be patient with this schedule and pray on it. I know many people will be upset because they want “their Mass time”, but remember, a couple of weeks ago, there were no public Mass times. As we walk with our brothers and sisters from these three other parishes and bring our gifts and our lives to the Lord’s altar, may we also walk with each other in their suffering. Together as one, with Christ’s help, may we embrace whatever sacrifices come our way. My prayers are with you all!
